Subject: Allocation of foodgrains to States/UTs under Wheat Based Nutrition Programme (WBNP) during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2011-12.

Sir/Madam

I am directed to convey the approval of the Government of India, Ministry of Women & Child Development for allocation of **65,667 MTs** (Sixty five thousand six hundred sixty seven only) of **Wheat**, **9115 MTs** (Nine thousand one hundred fifteen only) of **Rice**, **2297 MTs** (Two thousand two hundred ninety seven only) of **Maize** and **1350 MTs** (One thousand three hundred fifty only) of **Jowar** to the State Governments as per the quantities mentioned against each, under **Wheat Based Nutrition Programme (WBNP)** for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2011-12:-

2. The allocated foodgrains should be lifted as per the guidelines laid down vide Department of Food & Public Distribution's letter No.1-2/2008-BP II dated

18.07.2008 and will be used for the beneficiaries of **ICDS Scheme only**. The State Governments are accordingly requested to properly monitor the lifting and utilization of foodgrains on quarterly basis and furnish the requisite information to this Ministry in the prescribed proforma.

3. The State Governments are requested to furnish the **Utilisation Certificate** for the foodgrains allocated during **2010-11 immediately** and the offtake/UC for the foodgrains allocated vide this sanction by 15.07.2011.

4. The State Governments are also requested to intimate the end use of the foodgrains allocated under the ICDS Scheme alongwith the offtake figures and UC.

5. The CIP of wheat and rice for **BPL is Rs.415/- and Rs.565/- per quintal** respectively, which is payable by the State to the FCI. The CIP of **Maize and Jowar** for BPL is Rs.300/- each, per quintal

6. The State Government may indent the allocated quantity of foodgrains from the Regional/District Offices of the Food Corporation of India. Separate instructions are being issued by the FCI for making available the requisite quantity of foodgrains to the State Government. In the meantime district-wise and block-wise allocation of requirement of foodgrains may be worked out and copies of the same sent to the Regional/District Officers of the Food Corporation of India and to this Ministry.

7. Stocks once issued to the State Government will not be taken back by the FCI. It will, therefore, be the responsibility of the State Government to ensure that the quantity of foodgrains supplied to them conform to the 'Fair Average Quality'. It may also be ensured that the FCI gets full payment (at BPL rates) in respect of foodgrains released by this Ministry under WBNP.
