4. The States shall maintain separate accounts and furnish information on actual expenditure incurred on supplementary nutrition every quarter. The information on expenditure on supplementary nutrition from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 30<sup>th</sup> June must be furnished by 31<sup>st</sup> July and for the period from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> September by 31<sup>st</sup> October and from the period from 1<sup>st</sup> October to 31<sup>st</sup> December by 31<sup>st</sup> January and from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> March by 30<sup>th</sup> April to enable the Department to work out the entitlement of Central assistance of each State Government/UT Administration.

3. This grant-in-aid is towards the non-recurring and recurring expenditure for the Kishori Shakti Yojana. The payment is provisional and is subject to final adjustment in the light of the audited figures of actual expenditure for the year as a whole.

4. The grant-in-aid is subject to the condition that when the Scheme is closed or abandoned, the proceeds from the disposal of assets built out of the whole or a portion of the grant sanctioned will be shared between the Central and State Governments in proportion with their respective shares in the capital cost to assets.
