Subject: Allocation of food grains to States/UTs under **Rajiv Gandhi Scheme for Empowement of Adolescent Girls - Sabla** during the 3rd quarter of 2011-12.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer OM No.4-8/2011-BP-II dated 11.5.2011 received from Department of Food & Public Distribution regarding allotment of 1,15,872 tonnes of wheat 1,57,026 tonnes of rice at Central Issue Price (CIP) applicable for Below Poverty Line (BPL) families under RGSEAG – **Sabla** for 2011-12 (copy enclosed) and to convey the approval of the Government of India, Ministry of Women & Child Development for allocation of **30852.14 MTs of Wheat** and **14100.79 MTs of Rice** for the 3rd quarter of 2011-12 under **Rajiv Gandhi Scheme for Empowerment of Adolescent Girls – Sabla** to the following State Governments as per details given below :-

2. The allocated foodgrains should be lifted as per the revised guidelines laid down vide Department of Food & Public Distribution's letter No.1-2/2007-BP III dated 27.06.2011 and will be used for the beneficiaries of *Sabla* scheme only. The State Governments are accordingly requested to properly monitor the lifting and utilization of food grains on quarterly basis and furnish the requisite information to this Ministry in the prescribed proforma.

3. The State Governments are requested to furnish the offtake/ UC for the quantity of food grain allocated vide this sanction by 25.1.2012 for processing further release of food grains under the scheme.

4. The State Government are also requested to intimate the end use of the foodgrains allocated under the *Sabla* Scheme alongwith the offtake figures and UC. The CIP of wheat and rice for BPL is Rs.415/- and Rs.565/- per quintal respectively, which is payable by the State to the FCI.


5. The State Government may indent the allocated quantity of foodgrains from the Regional/District Offices of the Food Corporation of India. Separate instructions are being issued by the FCI for making available the requisite quantity of foodgrains to the State Government. In the meantime district-wise and block-wise allocation of requirement of foodgrains may be worked out and copies of the same sent to the Regional/District Officers of the Food Corporation of India and to this Ministry.

6. Stocks once issued to the State Government will not be taken back by the FCI. It will, therefore, be the responsibility of the State Government to ensure that the quantity of foodgrains supplied to them conform to the 'Fair Average Quality'. It may also be ensured that the FCI gets full payment (at BPL rates) in respect of food grains released by this Ministry under WBNP for *Sabla*.



7. States/UTs are allowed to lift the quantities of food grains vide this sanction, if at least 70% of the foodgrains allocated upto second quarter of 2011-12 have been lifted by the States/UTs. However, exceptions have been made in respect of seven States/UTs i.e. Chhattisgarh, Goa, Jharkhand, Kerala, Maharashtra, Manipur and Mizoram as they are allocated the foodgrains for the first time during the year 2011-12.

The Manager, (Sales), FCI, 16-20, Barakhambha Road, New Delhi with the request that necessary instructions may please be issued for supply of 30852.14 MTs of Wheat and 14100.79 MTs of Rice for the 3rd quarter of 2011-12 under Rajiv Gandhi Scheme for Empowerment of Adolescent Girls – *Sabla* as per the details mentioned in para 1 of this sanction. The price of foodgrains at BPL rate may be charged from the concerned States/UTs. States/UTs may be allowed to lift the quantities of food grains allocated for the 3rd quarter of 2011-12 only after at least 70% of the foodgrains allocated upto second quarter of 2011-12 have been lifted by the States/UTs. However, exceptions have been made in respect of seven States/UTs i.e. Chhattisgarh, Goa, Jharkhand, Kerala, Maharashtra, Manipur and Mizoram as they are allocated the foodgrains for the first time during the year 2011-12
